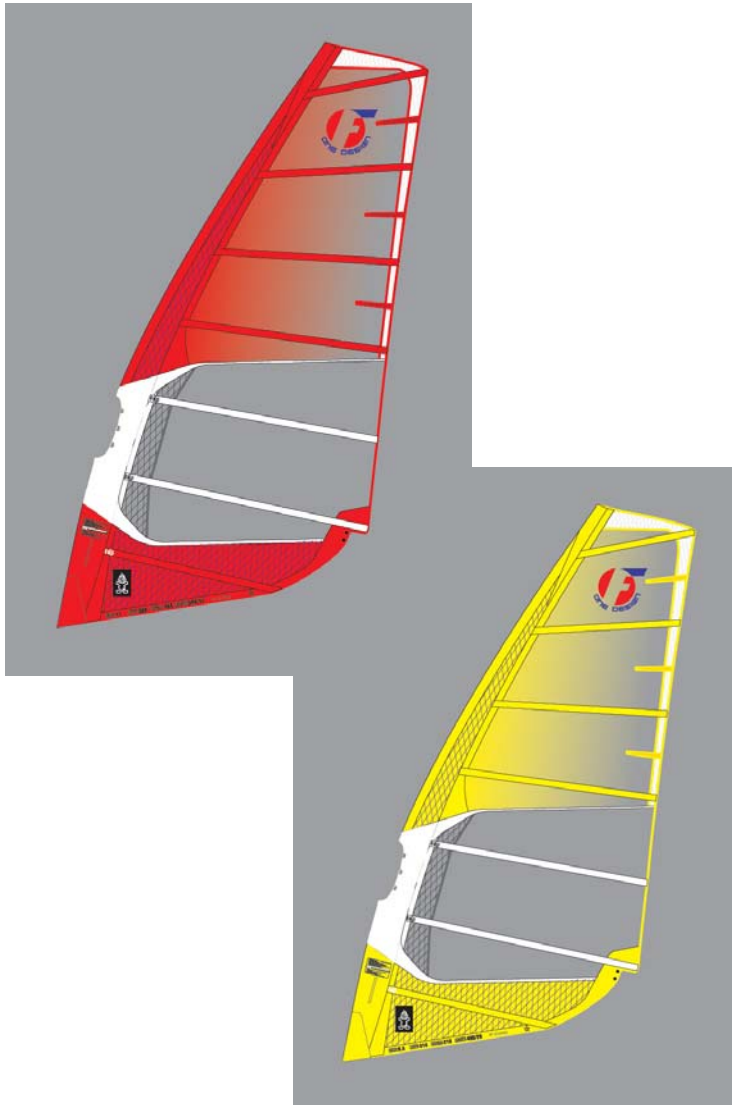

APPEAL TO RACERS

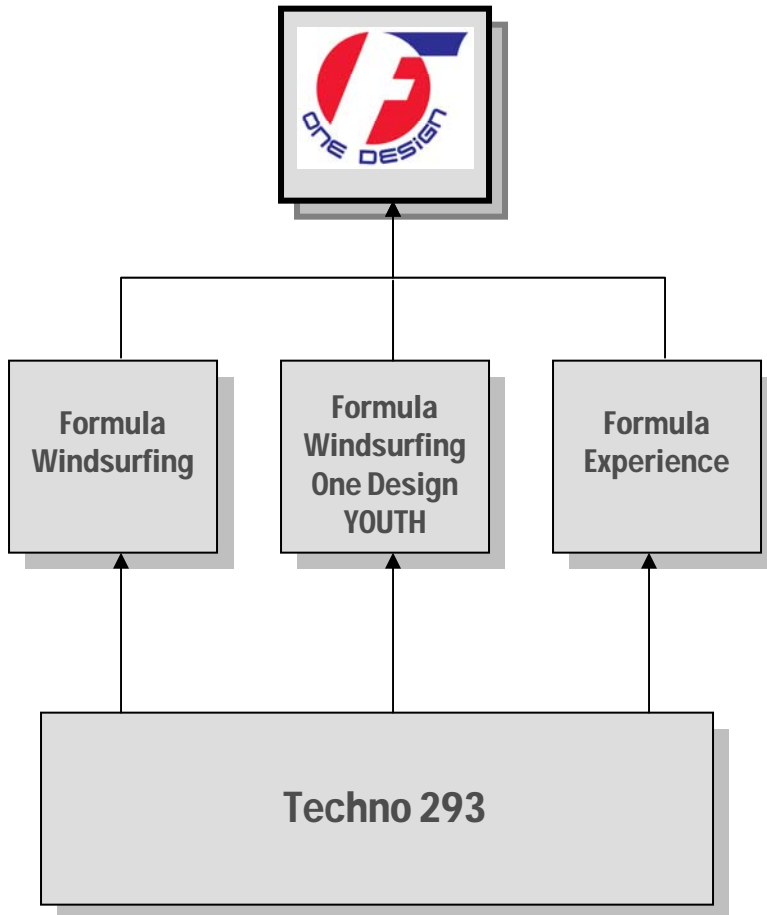
- Powerful sails with a wide wind range

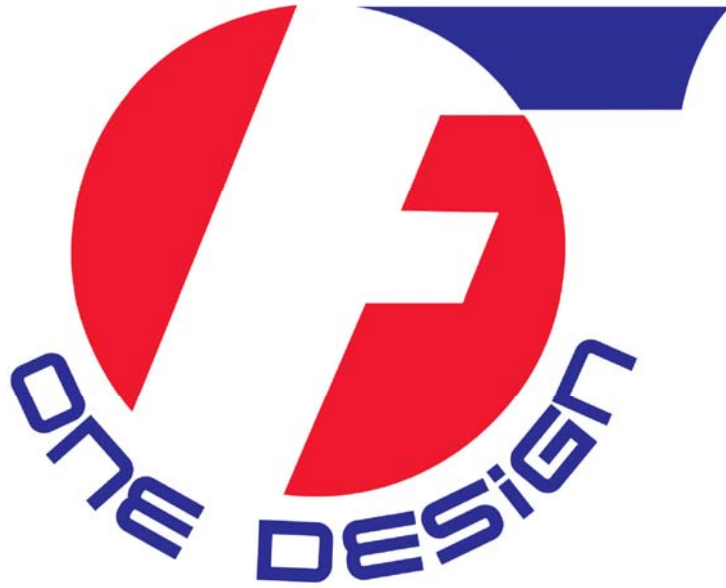

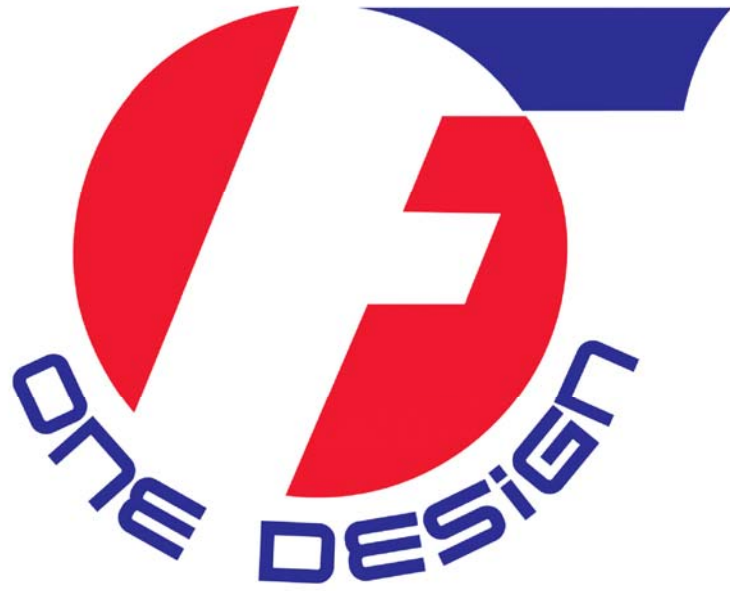
